## **For the safety, security and enjoyment of all of our guests, the following rules must be followed:**

- ◆ The legal drinking age onboard is 21 and is strictly enforced. We do not permit the purchase of drinks or bottles of liquor by adults for minors. *Possession of alcohol by a minor will not be tolerated and any found will be confiscated (even if found in cabin).*
- ◆ Passengers under the age of 18 are not permitted to use casinos or over 18 designated lounges.
- ◆ Must attend all onboard Mandatory Meetings that are set by Festivals At Sea and the cruise line.
- ◆ Purchase, possession, and/or consumption of drugs is illegal.
- ◆ No abusive, offensive, or vulgar language or gestures should be directed to other guests or to staff and crew.
- ◆ Large radios (“boom boxes”) are not permitted on board.
- ◆ Headphones must be used with radios on deck.
- ◆ No running, congregation, or consumption of food in hallways.
- ◆ No noise in cabin areas or corridors after 11:00 PM. Curfew set by group leaders, but no later than 1:00 AM.
- ◆ Excessive disturbance on board the ship will also result in loss of damage/student guideline deposit.
- ◆ No abuse of physical property.

I authorize the chaperon in for the named group to make any necessary parental decisions concerning any routine or emergency medical attention that might be required during the cruise.

Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in immediate corrective action by the cruise line’s security department. If the problem persists, the offender will be removed from the ship to make his or her own way home (at their own expense). Alternatively, if at sea, the disruptive guest(s) may be confined in their stateroom for the duration of the voyage.
